

There are few things powerful and important to people. Often America is celebrated as a culture that forgets. This museum seeks to help all Americans remember, and by remembering, this Smithsonian museum will stimulate a dialogue about race and help to foster a spirit of reconciliation and healing. This will be a place of meaning, memory, reflection, laughter, and hope; a beacon reminding us of what we were; what challenges we face, and pointing us towards what we can become.

### Day 1

Arrive in our **Nation's Capital**. Meet our professional **African American Heritage Guide**. Enjoy lunch included at the very popular **Ben's Chili Bowl**, a DC landmark. After lunch depart for a guided tour including the **African American Civil War Museum and Memorial**. Continue with a driving tour by historic sites: **Thurgood Marshall Center, Howard University, Lincoln Theatre, Bohemian Caverns, Freedom Plaza, the Willard Hotel**. Check in to our local hotel to rest and freshen up before we depart for dinner included. L, D

### Day 2

Breakfast is included at our hotel each morning. Today's touring includes **Cedar Hill**, the historic home of Frederick Douglass, **Lincoln Park**, and the **Martin Luther King, Jr. National Memorial**. Stand on the steps of the **Lincoln Memorial** where Dr. King delivered his 'I Have a Dream' speech. We'll arrive for lunch on own and free time to visit the 'new' **National Museum of African American History and Culture**.

Dinner is included this evening. After dinner depart for an **Illuminated Monument Tour** of Washington's famous memorials and monuments. B, D

### Day 3

Today, we'll enjoy a **Gospel Brunch** at a historic location before we depart for Baltimore. In **Baltimore** you'll have free time in the **Inner Harbor** for lunch on own and shopping. This afternoon, tour the **Reginald F. Lewis Museum of Maryland African American History**. Next, we'll visit **Douglass Place** to be greeted by **Frederick Douglass** (re-enactor). See the five alley houses he built and learn about his life in Baltimore. Mr. Douglass will step on the bus and give us a tour of **Fells Point**, focusing on his history and the shipyard where he worked as a slave. Dinner is included this evening before we return to our hotel for the night. B, D

### Day 4

This morning, we depart for the **Harriet Tubman Trail Tour**. Tour includes **Baltimore's Orchard Street Baptist Church** where we'll meet **Harriet Tubman** (re

-enactor), before continuing to **Dorchester County, Maryland**, and the **Harriet Tubman Trail**. We'll make stops at and/or drive by the **Harriet Tubman Museum and Visitor Center, Long Wharf, Harriet Tubman Historical Marker/Brodas Plantation, Bucktown Village Store, and Scotts Chapel/Bucktown United Methodist Church**. Dinner is included. After dinner return to the hotel for the evening. B, D

### **Day 5**

After breakfast and checking out, we'll depart for additional time at the 'new' **National Museum of African American History and Culture** before we continue home. B
