Today, the property is a **National Historic Landmark** open to the public as a historic **house museum** where the traditions of **collecting, entertaining, and patriotic service** still continue. And for your additional eye-candy pleasure, tour beautiful **Hillwood Estate and Gardens**. **Dinner is included** this evening prior to an after dark, **Illuminated Monument Tour** to witness the massive monuments of the Capital stunningly lit with soft lights. ### Saturday - Embassy Event & National Gallery of Art
