Day 1: April 17, 2026 - Historic Richmond (5-, 6-, & 7-day tours)

Begin in Richmond with visits to St. John's Church, where Patrick Henry declared "Give me liberty or give me death!", and the Virginia State Capitol, designed by Thomas Jefferson. After a taste of Revolutionary history, travel to Hampton for dinner and hotel check-in.

Day 2: April 18, 2026 - Colonial Williamsburg & Jamestown (all tours)

Step back in time with a guided tour of Colonial Williamsburg, including the Capitol and Governor's Palace. Enjoy lunch at Merchant's Square before exploring Jamestown Settlement's ships, fort, and living history. Conclude with dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 3: April 19, 2026 - The Virginia International Tattoo (all tours)

<u>Day 5: April 21, 2026 - Naval & Maritime Heritage</u> (6- & 7-day tours | 5-day departs)
