Day One - Virginia Beach & Holiday Lights on The Boardwalk

The Governor's Palace reflects the period of Lord Dunmore's residence, the last English governor of the Virginia colony. Board motorcoach and visit **Edgewood Plantation**. Throughout its dramatic history, it has served as a church, post office, telephone exchange, restaurant, nursing home and a signal post for the Confederates to spy on McLellan's Army. The estate also includes the 1725 Benjamin Harris Grist Mill. And then inside beautifully decorated for the season. Enjoy an included lunch at a nearby **Tavern** before departing for home.
