

Day 1 - Welcome to Music City

Day 2 - The Sound of Nashville

Step into music history at RCA Studio B, where legends recorded the Nashville Sound. Try your hand at songwriting during an interactive session, then visit the Country Music Hall of Fame and go behind the scenes on a backstage tour of the Grand Ole Opry.

Day 3 - Icons & Honky Tonks

Tour the Ryman Auditorium, the "Mother Church of Country Music," and explore the Johnny Cash and Patsy Cline Museums. Visit the Musicians Hall of Fame before an evening of live music and nightlife along Nashville's famous Honky Tonk Row.

Day 4 - Presidential Past & Tennessee Whiskey

Tour Andrew Jackson's Hermitage and enjoy free time for lunch and shopping in charming Franklin. Sample small-batch spirits on a tasting tour at Leiper's Fork Distillery, then continue to Muscle Shoals for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 - The Sound of Muscle Shoals

Visit the legendary FAME Recording Studios and Muscle Shoals Sound Studio, where Aretha Franklin and the Swampers made musical magic. Explore the Alabama Music Hall of Fame, followed by a lively dinner at an iconic, historic location—complete with Elvis memories, BBQ, and local music.

Day 6 - Elvis Begins

In Tupelo, tour the Elvis Presley Birthplace, Museum, and Park, and stop at the hardware store where he got his first guitar. After lunch, head to Memphis — the home of the blues — for a delicious dinner and your first night in the city.

Day 7 - Graceland & Soul of Memphis

Walk in the King's footsteps with the full Elvis Experience Tour at Graceland, then explore the Stax Museum of American Soul Music. Hop aboard the epic Backbeat Mojo Tour for a rollicking, music-filled ride through Memphis with live Beale Street musicians.

Day 8 - Civil Rights & Rock 'n' Soul

Tour the National Civil Rights Museum at the Lorraine Motel, then enjoy a Southern BBQ lunch. Continue to the Rock & Soul Museum and Sun Studio, the birthplace of rock 'n' roll, before an evening on your own along lively Beale Street.

Day 9 - Johnny Cash & Delta Heritage

Visit Johnny Cash's Boyhood Home in Dyess, Arkansas, explore the Southern Tenant Farmer's Museum, and stop at the movie set of A Painted House. Return to Memphis for another night of entertainment and dining downtown.

Day 10 - Proud Mary & Farewell

Pay tribute to the Queen of Rock at the Tina Turner Museum in her Tennessee hometown. Enjoy a farewell lunch at the Old Country Store before heading to the Nashville Airport to conclude your journey through America's Music Triangle.

Follow the beat through America's Music Triangle — from Nashville's honky tonks to the legendary studios of Muscle Shoals and the soulful streets of Memphis.

Step into the stories of country, soul, and rock 'n' roll where the music never fades and the rhythm of the South comes alive!
