Fireworks Spectacular & A Salute to Our Heroes

A Boston Pops Salute to Our Heroes celebrates the everyday heroes among us through music and a fireworks display. The Fireworks Spectacular is one of the country's largest and oldest public Fourth of July events and one of the biggest annual outdoor concerts anywhere in the world. The program will feature chorus members and symphony orchestras.

The tradition includes a massive 20-minute firework show accompanied by the music of the Boston Pops and other popular music of the past and present.



SAMPLE ITINERARY

DAY ONE -

Arrive in Boston, MA, and meet your step-on Guide to begin your Driving/Walking Tour of the Freedom Trail where you'll see:

- The State House atop Beacon Hill.
- Walk Boston Common, America's Oldest public park.

- Old State House, the oldest surviving public building in Boston, circa 1713.
- USS Constitution
