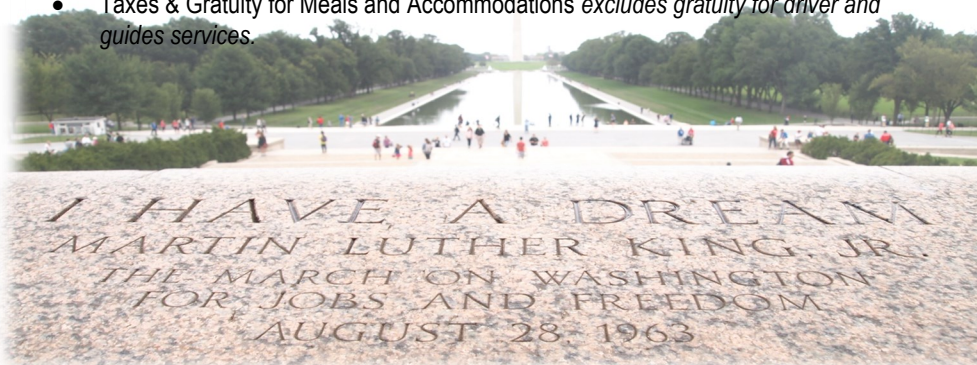
Harriet Tubman Trail, Martin Luther King, Jr., and Frederick Douglass
