Itinerary

Day 1 – Welcome to the South

Travel through Civil War history and Alabama music country as you visit Corinth's historic landmarks and museums before continuing to the Shoals region. Discover the fascinating story of Helen Keller & cap off the evening with delicious Southern cuisine and live entertainment by local Muscle Shoals musicians.
