Itinerary

DAY 1 - Hampton to Maryland's Eastern Shore

Arrive in Hampton, Virginia, and explore the historic campus of Hampton University, including the Emancipation Oak and the nation's oldest African American museum. Travel to Maryland's Eastern Shore and settle in with a delicious and locally-sourced Welcome Dinner along the waterfront.

DAY 2 - Harriet's Homeland & The Underground Railroad

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel each morning. This morning, journey through the landscapes of Harriet Tubman's early life, including Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge and key historic sites along the Underground Railroad. Explore the Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad Visitor Center and enjoy a special luncheon at a historic Black church, followed by a delightful Dinner Cruise on the Choptank River.

DAY 3 - The Tubman Byway to Philadelphia

Travel the scenic Tubman Byway, tracing the path to freedom through Maryland and Delaware into Philadelphia. Along the way, experience the stories and sites that formed a vital corridor of the Underground Railroad.

DAY 4 - Philadelphia to Baltimore: Freedom & Legacy

Explore Philadelphia's role in the fight for freedom with a Guided Tour along America's most historic mile and visits to Independence Hall, the Liberty Bell, and the African American Museum. Continue to Baltimore for an included dinner and evening at leisure.

DAY 5 - Baltimore & Reflection

Visit the Reginald F. Lewis Museum for a powerful look at Maryland's African American history. Enjoy free time along the Inner Harbor before departing for home, reflecting on the legacy of Harriet Tubman and the journey to freedom.

Walk through history with one of America's greatest heroes on this powerful journey along the Harriet Tubman Trail.

From the Eastern Shore to Philadelphia and Baltimore, experience the landscapes, stories, and courage that shaped the Underground Railroad.
