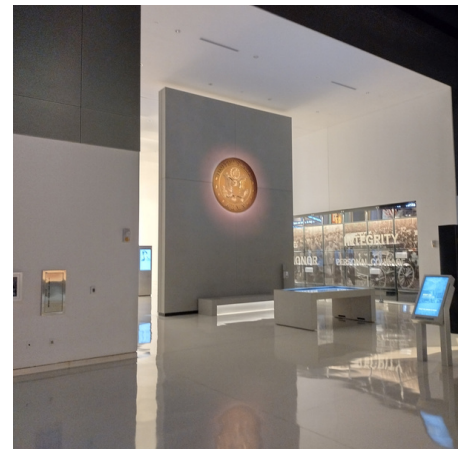
Thursday, November 9, 2023 - Welcome to D.C.
