Itinerary

Day 1 - April 23, 2027 – Historic Richmond

Begin in Richmond with visits to St. John's Church, where Patrick Henry declared "Give me liberty or give me death!" & the VA State Capitol, designed by Thomas Jefferson. After a taste of history, travel to Hampton for dinner and hotel check-in to rest & relax.

Day 2 - April 24, 2027 – Colonial Williamsburg & Jamestown
