- Dine at a local Cajun restaurant, complete with an interactive Cajun Cooking Demonstration and Live Creole and Zydeco Music.

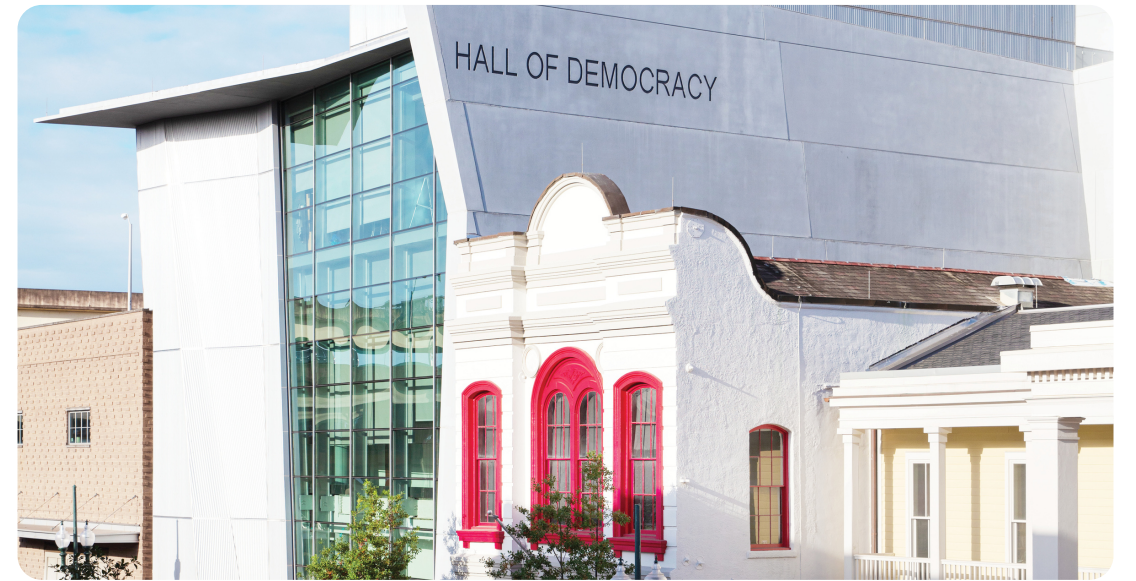
Day 5

- Dine at an antebellum mansion which has been converted into a restaurant.



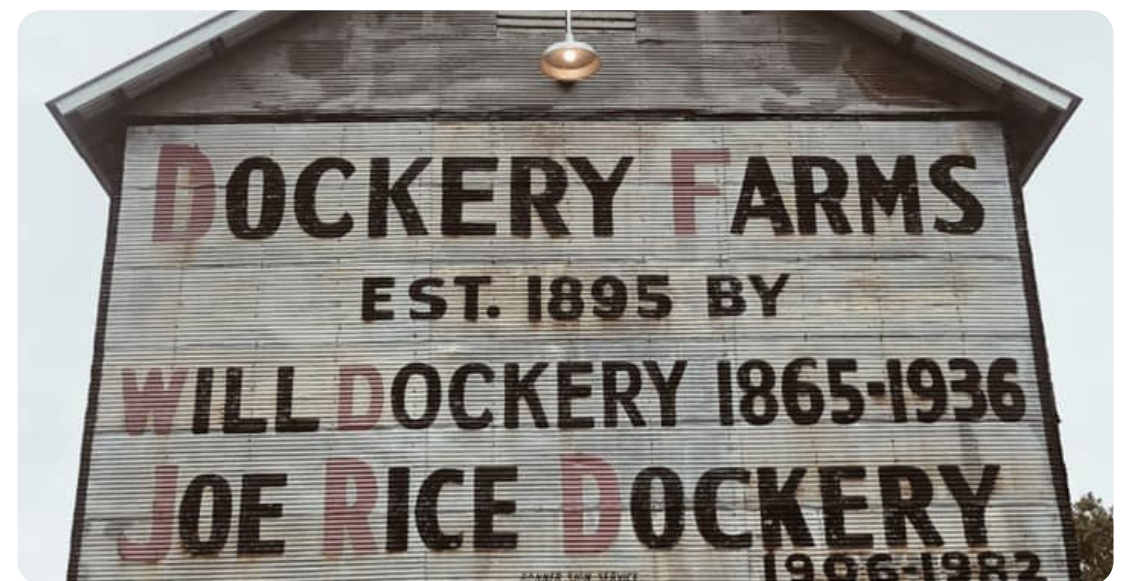
Day 7
