#### DAY 1 – Welcome to Memphis

#### DAY 3 – Birmingham to Selma

Explore Birmingham's pivotal role in the movement with visits to Kelly Ingram Park and 16th Street Baptist Church. Discover the city's cultural legacy before traveling to Selma for dinner and overnight.

#### DAY 4 – Selma to Montgomery

Walk across the Edmund Pettus Bridge and visit the National Voting Rights Museum. Continue to the Lowndes Interpretive Center before arriving in Montgomery for dinner and reflection.

#### DAY 5 – Montgomery

Experience powerful sites including the Legacy Museum and National Memorial for Peace and Justice. Visit Dexter Avenue King Memorial Baptist Church, the Rosa Parks Museum, and other landmarks that shaped the fight for equality.

#### DAY 6 – Tuskegee to Atlanta

Visit the Tuskegee Airmen National Historic Site before continuing to Atlanta. Explore The King Center and Ebenezer Baptist Church, and enjoy a farewell dinner at a classic Southern restaurant.

#### DAY 7 – Departure

Depart for home with a deeper understanding of the people, places, and stories that shaped the Civil Rights Movement.
