## SAMPLE ITINERARY

### DAY ONE - Baltimore, "Charm City"

Arrive in Baltimore, MD, meet your Guide, and embark on a City Tour with a visit to Fort McHenry, the Fort whose War of 1812 victory inspired "The Star-Spangled Banner".

Enjoy a Tour & Rye Whiskey Tasting at Sagamore Spirit Distillery.

Check-in to your local hotel, followed by a Welcome Dinner of fresh Maryland seafood at a local favorite location.

### DAY TWO - Baltimore, "Charm City"

Enjoy an Instagram-worthy breakfast included at the famous Miss Shirley's.

Explore the National Aquarium, home to 20,000 animals - sharks, turtles, free-flying birds, and more - all in award-winning habitats.

Visit the historic B&O Railroad Museum, highlighting nearly 200 locomotives, a model train display & train rides.

Sail away on a narrated Harbor Cruise this afternoon and see the city from the water with epic views and insightful historical tales.

### DAY THREE - Annapolis & Cape May

### DAY FIVE - Philadelphia

Meet your Guide in the historic district where you'll have lunch on own before setting off on a walking tour to see such notable sites as the Betsy Ross House, Christ Church, the Liberty Bell, and Independence Hall.

Dinner is included at a historic local restaurant before returning to the hotel.

### DAY SIX - Lancaster

Enjoy breakfast prior to checking out.

Experience the beauty of the Amish countryside in Lancaster with a local Guide. Visit the Kitchen Kettle Village for shopping and lunch on own followed by an authentic Country Buggy Ride.

Check-in to your local Lancaster hotel prior to a hearty Amish dinner included with farm fresh, homemade fare.

### DAY SEVEN - Lancaster

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel this morning.

Continue your Amish adventure with a visit to Kreider Farms and a Turkey Hill Ice Cream Experience this morning.

Have lunch on own while visiting the unique town of Lititz, PA, featuring local art galleries, chic boutiques, antique shops, cozy cafes, and restaurants.

Tour the Ephrata Cloister, a museum showcasing the religious Ephrata Community established in 1732.

Delight with dinner and a show this evening at one of the area's famous locations.

### DAY EIGHT - Gettysburg

Enjoy breakfast prior to checking out.

Visit Gettysburg and embark on a Battlefield Guided Tour before exploring the Gettysburg Visitor Center where history comes alive in the Cyclorama, a restored, 360-degree 1800s painting with light & sound effects, recounting a key Civil War conflict. Enjoy lunch on own while visiting.

Explore Eisenhower Farm. Adjacent to the Gettysburg battlefield, the farm served the president and first lady as a weekend retreat and as a meeting place for world leaders.

Check-in to your local hotel before a delicious dinner included at a historic local tavern.

### DAY NINE - Farewell

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before checking out and departing for home.
