

Day One: Welcome to Colonial Virginia

Day Five: From Old Town to Mount Vernon

Stroll through charming Old Town Alexandria and tour sites tied to George Washington's daily life. Then visit his beloved Mount Vernon estate, including the family tomb and historic distillery. Wrap up with a Farewell Dinner in a historic tavern dating back to the 1700s.

Day Six: A Capitol Farewell

After breakfast, tour George Washington's Masonic Temple for stunning views and rare artifacts, then explore the Anderson House, home to Revolutionary-era treasures. Enjoy a final lunch on your own at DC's vibrant new food hall, The Square, before departing for home.
