**Day One**

Embark on a Guided Tour of the Pearl S. Buck House, the former home of the Nobel and Pulitzer Prize-winning author. Explore the beautiful gardens and grounds during your free time. A boxed lunch will be provided as you travel to the Michener Art Museum, where a docent-led tour awaits. Enjoy the museum's exquisite collections and take some time to explore on your own. Later, visit the serene Our Lady of Czestochowa Shrine, a spiritual and cultural landmark. End the day with a fantastic dinner included.

**Day Four**

Visit Glen Foerd, a stunning historic estate with beautiful gardens and river views. Next, explore Andalusia, another impressive mansion renowned for its Greek Revival architecture and lush grounds. Enjoy lunch at a historic location capturing the essence of colonial charm. In the afternoon, tour the Grundy Museum, showcasing Victorian-era life in Bucks County. Spend the evening shopping and dining at your own pace in Peddler's Village, a charming shopping village with unique boutiques and eateries.

**Day Five**

Explore Pennsbury Manor, the recreated colonial estate of William Penn, the founder of Pennsylvania. Then, take a Guided Tour of the historic Washington Crossing Park, where General George Washington famously crossed the Delaware River during the American Revolution. Enjoy a delicious lunch at a nearby inn steeped in history. In the afternoon, explore the enchanting Grounds for Sculpture, an outdoor sculpture park and museum. Dinner will be a memorable experience at a unique restaurant within the park, surrounded by art and nature. Return to the hotel for your final night.

**Day Six**

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel before checking out. The morning is free for you to relax or explore additional sights based on your group's interests and departure schedule.
