YORKTOWN Victory Parade

OCTOBER 16-21, 2026

Day 1 - Friday, October 16, 2026

Step into history as you arrive in Old Town Alexandria for lunch on your own along picturesque Union Street. Afterward, set sail aboard the Tall Ship Providence for a dockside tour and cruise, plus a glass of wine (or beer), where you'll meet historical figures and even learn to load a cannon! Dive deeper into Old Town Alexandria's colonial past with a Guided Tour along charming cobblestone streets. See Christ Church, Gadsby's Tavern Museum, and more! Cap off the day with a delightful dinner at Gadsby's Tavern, hosted by none other than Martha Washington herself!

Day 2 - Saturday, October 17, 2026

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel each morning. Today, visit the majestic Mount Vernon, the beloved estate of George Washington, to explore its fascinating grounds and museum exhibits. After lunch, continue to Gunston Hall, home of George Mason, where you'll uncover stories of American rights and the lives of those who lived and labored there. Day 6 - Wednesday, October 21, 2026

The Siege of Yorktown was the last major battle of the American Revolutionary war and led to the surrender of General Cornwallis.
