Itinerary

Day 1 - Fiddles & Front Porch Fun in Floyd

Arrive in the charming mountain town of Floyd, VA and dive straight into the region's musical roots with an authentic Old-Time Music Jam—bring your instrument or simply soak in the sound. Browse the beloved Floyd Country Store and local artisan shops before settling into your hotel. This evening, stroll to Dogtown Roadhouse for open mic night, live bluegrass, and a lively, come-as-you-are atmosphere filled with music, dancing, and Appalachian spirit.

Day 2 - Blue Ridge Beauty & Bluegrass Heritage

Travel the breathtaking Blue Ridge Parkway with a stop at iconic Mabry Mill, one of the most photographed spots in the region. In Galax, Virginia—the heart of bluegrass—enjoy a Guided Heritage experience with visits to Barr's Fiddle Shop, the historic Rex Theater, the Blue Ridge Music Center, and more. Continue to Mount Airy, North Carolina to explore the Old-Time Music Heritage Hall, home to one of the nation's longest-running live radio broadcasts.

Journey to Bristol, Virginia with a nostalgic stop at Wily's Service Station and a visit to the Andy Griffith Playhouse. Continue to the historic streets of Abingdon, Virginia, where you'll settle in, enjoy time to refresh, and gather for dinner at a popular local restaurant.

Explore the Edith Bolling Wilson Birthplace Museum before heading to Bristol, Tennessee. Browse regional art and crafts at the Southwest Virginia Cultural Center & Marketplace, then cap off the day with an unforgettable performance at Wohlfahrt Haus Dinner Theatre.

Explore charming, downtown Staunton, Virginia before visiting the Woodrow Wilson Presidential Library and Museum.
