Itinerary

Day 1 - Journey to Maryland's Eastern Shore

Your journey begins with a comfortable ride to Maryland's scenic Eastern Shore, where history and hospitality await. Settle into your hotel in Easton before heading to charming St. Michaels for a delicious waterfront Welcome Dinner. It's the perfect introduction to the region's rich maritime heritage and relaxing coastal atmosphere.

Day 2 - In the Footsteps of Harriet Tubman

Today is a deeply moving exploration of Harriet Tubman's life and legacy in her birthplace of Dorchester County. Walk the grounds where enslaved people were once bought and sold, visit museums preserving her story, and experience the landscapes that shaped her courage. From hidden safe houses to historic communities of free African Americans, this powerful day brings the Underground Railroad vividly to life. Enjoy some famous, Maryland-style crab cakes at an iconic eastern shore location before returning to the hotel.

Day 3 - From Freedom's Shores to the NMAAHC

After breakfast depart for Washington, DC, to dive deeper into the centuries of African American history at one of the nation's premier museums: the National Museum of African American History and Culture (NMAAHC) showcasing the stories of resilience, achievement, and cultural impact.
