



Legends, Prairies, & the Medora Musical

From Minneapolis to the Badlands of North Dakota

Day 1 – Minneapolis & Mall of America

Arrive in Minneapolis/Bloomington, MN and enjoy time to explore, shop, and dine at the famous Mall of America. Optional adventures include Nickelodeon Universe Theme Park or SEA LIFE Aquarium. Choose from more than 50 dining options for your evening meal. Overnight at the Radisson BLU, conveniently connected to Mall of America via Sky Bridge.

Day 2 – Minneapolis, Paisley Park & Dinner Theater

Travel to downtown Minneapolis to tour the Mill City Museum and explore the Mississippi River area. Enjoy a picnic lunch at the Riverfront District and Mill Ruins Park. Continue to Paisley Park for a tour of Prince's former home and music studio. This evening, enjoy dinner and a show at the Chanhassen Dinner Theater featuring *Guys and Dolls*, including your meal. Overnight at the Radisson BLU.

Day 3 – Fargo & Bonanzaville

Travel by motorcoach to Fargo, ND with a stop at the Fargo-Moorhead Visitors Center. Continue to Brewhalla, an exciting indoor market featuring unique gifts, local art, foods, drinks, treats, and live music. Later, visit Bonanzaville in West Fargo, a fascinating museum complex featuring 47 historic buildings spread across 12 acres. Overnight in Fargo.

Day 4 – Buffalo, Prairies & Riverboat Dining

Depart Fargo and travel west to Jamestown, ND to visit the National Buffalo Museum. Explore the museum's old-time town atmosphere, enjoy mid-morning snacks, and take photos with the world's largest buffalo statue. Continue to Bismarck with a stop at Black Leg Ranch for a catered lunch and an engaging look at buffalo and cattle ranching, prairie history, and the settlers who shaped the region. Later, visit the North Dakota Capitol Grounds Heritage Center before enjoying dinner aboard the Lewis & Clark Riverboat Dinner Cruise in Bismarck. Overnight in Bismarck.

Day 5 – Enchanted Highway & Western North Dakota

Travel from Bismarck to the Knife River Indian Villages National Historic Site before driving along the famous Enchanted Highway, stopping to admire the incredible large-scale sculpture installations along



the route. In Regent, ND, enjoy lunch and drinks at the Enchanted Castle Restaurant & Tavern. Continue to Dickinson for dinner at The Grub Tub rooftop, free live music at Legacy Square, and time to stroll the downtown streets. Overnight in Dickinson.

Day 6 – Medora & The Medora Musical

Travel to Medora, ND with a stop at Painted Canyon Visitors Center for the chance to see live roaming buffalo. Spend time exploring Medora’s museums via shuttle, browsing unique gift shops, and shopping for western-themed clothing, boots, or cowboy hats while keeping an eye out for the town’s Teddy Roosevelt impersonator. Enjoy lunch at either Little Missouri Saloon & Dining or Boots Bar & Grill for an authentic western dining experience. Later, visit the Chateau de Mores State Historic Site, the summer home of the Marquis de Mores, founder of Medora. This evening, experience the famous Pitchfork Steak Fondue and the spectacular Medora Musical at the Burning Hills Amphitheatre. Overnight in Medora.

Day 7 – Departure Day

Travel to Dickinson or Bismarck, ND for your flight home. Guests may also choose the optional transfer to Rapid City, SD for departure arrangements.
