Itinerary

Day 1 – Bowling Green, Kentucky

Kick off an Elvis Week of adventure with a fun visit to Bowling Green's fascinating National Corvette Museum, home to more than 170 classic and concept Corvettes displayed in unique period settings. After, settle into your hotel and enjoy an evening at leisure.

Day 2 – Bowling Green to Tupelo

Start the day with behind-the-scenes experiences in Bowling Green, including a tour of RC Components and a visit to Chaney's Dairy Farm, where robotic technology and lasers make for an unusual and quite entertaining farm experience. Then travel south along the scenic Natchez Trace Parkway, with a stop to walk a section of the historic Old Trace, before arriving in Tupelo for dinner at a local favorite restaurant.

Day 3 – Tupelo & Memphis

Step into Elvis' earliest years with a visit to his birthplace home and Elvis Presley Park, then stop at Tupelo Hardware Company, where Elvis' mother purchased his first guitar. After exploring Tupelo's Civil War history and the Tupelo Automobile Museum — including an Elvis-owned Lincoln — continue to Memphis for dinner included and an unforgettable Elvis Week candlelight vigil at Graceland.

Day 4 – Graceland & Memphis

Today is all about Elvis! Explore Graceland, his legendary home, along with his airplanes and Elvis museum exhibits. Continue to Sun Studio, where Elvis began his recording career, then experience the one-of-a-kind Memphis Pyramid before enjoying free time, dinner and live music on historic Beale Street. Cap the evening with a special Elvis concert — a fitting way to celebrate the King during Elvis Week.

Day 5 – Memphis to Nashville

Journey toward Nashville with a fascinating stop at the Fire Museum of Memphis, followed by lunch at Loretta Lynn's Kitchen. Visit Fontanel, the former home of country music legend Barbara Mandrell, for a Guided Tour, Wine Tasting and dinner before checking into the spectacular Gaylord Opryland Resort.

Day 6 – Nashville: Music City

Immerse yourself in the sounds of Music City with a visit to the Country Music Hall of Fame, including a special "Stories Behind the Song" tour, followed by lunch line dancing at the Wildhorse Saloon. Then visit Studio B, where Elvis recorded many of his later hits, before enjoying the evening at the legendary Grand Ole Opry, with premium seating for the show.

Day 7 – Nashville & Journey Home

Visit Andrew Jackson's The Hermitage, for a Guided Tour. Continue to Hendersonville to explore Johnny Cash's gravesite, followed by a drive-by of Conway Twitty's former home, then begin the journey home filled with memories of an incredible Elvis Week adventure.

Celebrate 50 years of Elvis with an unforgettable journey through the places, music and memories that made the King of Rock 'n' Roll a legend!

From his humble beginnings in Tupelo to Graceland and the excitement of Elvis Week in Memphis, this star-studded adventure also explores the musical heart of Nashville.
